GUIDANCE NOTES FOR PLAYER REGISTRATION FORM IN ACCORDANCE WITH RFU REGULATION 14

SECTION 3	17 year olds playing adult rugby Players may only play adult rugby, or train with other adults, when they have reached their eighteenth birthday unless they are aged 17 and have been assessed as capable of playing with adults and the RFU's playing adult rugby form has been duly completed and signed in accordance with RFU Regulation 15. It will not be possible to register a 17 year old to play adult rugby unless the form has been duly completed and signed, confirmation of this undertaking is in Section [3] of the Player Registration Form.								
SECTION 4	Where the player's country of birth is not the UK and he is registering for a club at level 1-4 (inc) or he is contracted non-UK born player at any level, a photocopy of the passport (identity page with photograph) and valid visa, must be submitted.								
SECTION 4 (EQP)	For Premiership & Championship clubs only Section 4 of the registration form relates to the RFU's England Qualified Player scheme and must be completed if the player meets the requirements for England eligibility. Subject to any information previously submitted to the RFU the club will be required to provide evidence to support the player's eligibility to play for England in accordance with IRB Regulation 8 and the RFU's EQP protocol.

Note: In the event that any amateur status information is not correct, and if the player is not an EU/UK citizen, you will be in breach of the UK immigration Law and the player may be deported, or if the player is an EU/UK citizen and is receiving illegal payments, you will be in breach of UK Law and may be reported by the Inland Revenue. The Rugby Football Union, in the case of incorrect information, may suspend your Player Registration.
